

What is the heart behind CHC providing childcare?

- Our Thursday afternoon meetups are designed to encourage parents and their K5–12th grade students in both fellowship and discipleship. Each activity is intentionally geared toward schoolaged children and integrates a biblical worldview into lessons, discussions, and projects. We believe this honors both Titus 2:4-5 (discipleship and encouragement for parents) and Proverbs 22:6 (training up children in the way they should go).
- To make this possible, parents stay with their K5–12th grade students in our designated area, where they can lend a hand as needed and enjoy connecting with other parents while their children learn and engage together.
- At the same time, we want to bless families by caring for our youngest children in a dedicated (and free!) childcare program for ages 0–4. This program, led by approved helpers who have completed background checks and training, provides a safe and nurturing environment just for little ones. (The only exception is nursing babies up to 6 months, who are welcome to stay with their moms.)
